

# **Top 10 Test-Taking Tips**

• **Give Yourself Time:** Get to your testing location 5-10 minutes early to get settled.

#### • Familiarize Yourself:

- o Look at the layout of your exam. Are you able to skip or flag questions?
- Read all instructions.
- Skim test questions.

### • Be Kind to Yourself:

Self-talk is powerful! Positive self-talk can be encouraging!

#### Know Where to Start:

 If you are able, begin where you feel most comfortable: first question, last question, or somewhere in the middle.

# • Process for Answering:

- O What type of question is it?
- O What is the topic? Do you understand what the question asks?
- o Have you ruled out any distractors?

## • Check for Absolutes:

- Absolutes cause most statements to be wrong.
- Examples: all, never, no, always, none, every, only

# Consider the Question:

- Ask yourself: What does my professor want me to know from this question?
- Trust Your Gut: Do not change your original answer unless you are confident.

#### Consider the Odds:

- Research shows that in T/F questions, the answer is more likely to be true.
  It's harder to create a false answer.
- Partial credit is better than no credit.
- Review Your Work: Review your answers and check for mistakes you may have made during your test.
