



International Admission Checklist

1. [International Admission Application](#)

2. **Application Fee: \$100** (paid through application page)

3. **Official Transcript***

- All academic records must be original or certified copies in a sealed envelope from the institution. Copies must be certified (both signed with the seal/stamp affixed) by a school official.
- Notarized copies will not be accepted.
- An official English transcript must be provided if the original transcript is in a different language.
- Students transferring from an overseas institution must have a course-by-course evaluation performed by members from NACES in order to apply for transfer credits.

*Applicant can upload their latest transcript and submit an official, final transcript afterward.

4. **English Proficiency Test.****

- Official TOEFL score report - 61 IBT, 500 Paper
- Official IELTS score report - 5.5 or above
- ACT/SAT score report card
 - ACT must be 19+ in both English Language and Reading
 - SAT must be 470+ in both Writing and Critical Reading
- Completion of ELS level 112
- Pearson Test of English Academic (PET) - 45 or above PTE academic score
- Michigan English Test (MET) - B2 or above
- Cambridge English Certificate
 - Cambridge English: Proficiency (CPE)
 - Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE)
 - Cambridge English: First (FCE)
- Completion of EF Level C1-3

**The English proficiency test may be waived if the student studied in a U.S. high school, college, or university and can show proof of completing English Composition I and II with a grade of C or above.

5. **Passport Information**

- Photocopy of the personal data page
- Photocopy of visa (if applicable)
- Photocopy of I-20 (if applicable)
- Photocopy of DS2019 (if applicable)

6. **Official Bank Statement**

- Signed and stamped
- Showing proof of financial resources (\$27,479 from either student or sponsor)

7. **Declaration and Confirmation of Financial Resources Form** (available on application page)

8. **Immunization Record**

- All students need to have at least two shots of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine.
- Can be provided after admission to UAFS.
