Arkansas State University Mid-South (ASU Mid-South) students interested in earning a Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership from the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith (UAFS) may complete the first two years (lower division coursework) of the bachelor’s degree requirements by completing an Associate of general Studies, Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree in programs approved by ASU Mid-South. Completed ASU Mid-South courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BSOL degree requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. UAFS will offer the remaining BSOL degree requirements through online courses. Per the partnership agreement, UAFS will transfer 75 hours of lower division coursework for the BSOL.
